C. Co. to refer to your letter
No. 48235 of the 20th ult. in regard
to the opening of a lumber road across
with Lots. Ephraim Reserve by John Robertson Jr. of
Chapman Falls for the purpose of hauling lumber
from that place to Lake Umbagog.
C. Co. to report that Chief Alexander Robie
states that Mr. Robertson is now using the
road for this purpose and complains of
his action upon their reserve.
In connection C. Co. to state that the
road in question is a series of saw-
log roads formerly used by the White-
Pine Lumber Co. when they were operating
upon that portion of the reserve and
Mr. Robertson had only to remove the debris
that accumulated since then to make it
suitable for the purpose.
