Re draft Leters Patent governing the office of Governor General

As mentioned over the telephone this morning
I am returning the Instrument herewith with the following suggestions:

- 1. to make sure that my signature appears where X is marked above "Canada"
- 2. to have words "Emperor of India" deleted after King George's name and attention of Lunday of Sleit drawn orths for all future use etc.

I agreed to deletion of words "under Our Great Seal of Canada"; also to change of date from first day of September 1947 to first day of October 1947.

I attach hereto, as requested by Mr. St.Laurent, a letter agreeing to foregoing recommendations. I am also quite agreeable to letter to Sir Alan Lascelles along line of draft and if letter is prepared I will sign.
