COMPOSITION AND RULES

(p) All nations shall be responsible for the good behaviour of individuals or organizations, i.e. Companies, Corporations, etc., who have controlling interests in such activities as Aircraft, Radio, Banking, etc., etc., and all other activities which are of an international nature and for which activity a sub-council has been formed.

BUREAU OF INFORMATION

A permanent institution of the International Court would be the Bureau of Information, staffed by competent advisors on all national and international matters. Their advice would be available to all nations at a nominal charge.

LIBRARY

The Bureau of Information would be supplemented by an up-to-date modern reference library, in which copies of all national and international laws, with complete records of International Court and Sub-Council activities. It would be the issu ing and recording office for all notices, etc., connected with International Court proceedings.
