earners, by the exportation of raw materials and semi-manufactured products.

8. USE SCIENCE FOR THE DE-TERMINATION AND DEVELOP-MENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES. Industrial research will reveal new wealth, improve industrial processes, and help to relieve our economic dependence upon outside sources for fuel, iron, and other essentials.

9. MAKE QUALITY THE HALL-MARK OF CANADIAN PRODUCTS. In return for public support of the home market Canadian manufacturers should provide products that compare favorably with imported goods and Canadian workers should recognize good workmanship and maximum poduction as their standards.

10. BE FAIR TO CAPITAL. Canadian money should be encouraged to invest at home and foreign capital attracted to promote Canadian industrial expansion.
