UNDESIRABLE EMIGRATION TO AMERICA.

The number of cheap workmen in the United States is being greatly augmented. The most recent addition has been a number of Hungarians who, in respect of living, are unlike the Chinese and who infest the larger cities of the neighboring republic. The Chinese have long been the pest of the laboring men of the States, who have had to work for a mere nothing in order to compete with their darker rival, who seem to be able to subsist on nothing. The Hungarians, like the Chinese, and the Italians, whose methods of life we are familiar with, do not come to America with the intention of remaining in it, but solely with the object of making money sufficient to enable them to live at home in ease after they have worked hard and lived on nothing in a country where they are not known. They take no interest in the affairs of the country, do not seek any way to advance its interests, nor to improve their own condition. It is to be hoped that employers will yet be able to consider the interests of their country, while looking after their own, and show to those who come to America merely to disgrace it, that we have no room for such inferior specimens of mankind.

THE SUPERANNUATION SYSTEM.

The cost of maintaining superannuated Dominion officials continues to be a heavy drain upon the people of Canada. The expenditure of this department continues rapidly to increase, while the amount paid in has increased but little. In 1886 there was paid to superannuated officials \$200,655, while last year \$202,285 were required for that purpose. During the past ten years the expenditure for superannuation has increased from \$105,588 to \$202,285 while the amount paid into the fund during that time has only increased from \$41,857 to \$62,609. In addition to the loss of \$150,000, occasioned by the operation of the superannuation act there is the loss to the country of the services of men well qualified for positions which they held, but which they were forced to vacate in order to make room for office seekers whose intellects were found unequal to the demands of mercantile or other positions not under the government's wing. Men in the full vigor of life have had from time to time to allow themselves to be placed on the superannuation list because Sir John and his colleagues were forced to find a place for the incompetent sons of influential men. Compared with the increase in expenditure for superannuation in Mr. Mackenzie's time the increase during Sir John's administration has been enormous. During the last three years of Mr. Mackenzie's rule the money paid in to the superannuation fund was nearly sufficient to meet the additional expenditure occasioned by the superannuation of officials whose age had made them unable to satisfactorily discharge the duties of their positions. The whole superannuation business needs a thorough sifting, and we doubt not that it will ere long get it.

THE EXTRADITION TREATY.

The British extradition treaty, now before the United States Senate, is attracting no little attention. The committee on foreign relations have recommended some important amendments to the treaty, so that the measure differs in several particulars from the draft published last year. The amendments are: That persons shall be extraditable, first, for larceny and second, for assault upon life with explosives. A Washington dispatch says that these two provisions are regarded as the most important in the treaty. "The first is the one upon which the Canadian government and the United States are understood to be in accord. It is designed to prevent Canada from being made a refuge for bank thieves and embezzlers, and to relieve it from being made a Botany Bay for the States. The benefits would be, of course, reciprocal, and the United States would no longer be the asylum for the Canadian embezzler, the thief of wire, and the assassin to be settled in that direction. The second provision is the one which takes the place of the somewhat broader original provision which was known as the dynamite clause. It has been thought that the second amendment removes some of the objections which were made to the original draft on political grounds. Mr. Bidwellberger, however, is not satisfied either with the original draft of the treaty, or with the proposed amendment, and he wishes to have an opportunity to open session to manifest his disposition to twist the tail of the British lion in the very face of Mr. Chamberlain and the fishery commission." The result of the Senate's deliberations will be looked for with interest.

AN ANIMATED CONTROVERSY.
