Canadian Woman Sentenced To Hang

Kingston, Sept. 28—After being out five hours the jury in the murder case of Mrs. Lovica Thompson, of Kennebec Township, Frontenac Co., brought in a verdict of (guilty) at the sitting of the Supreme Court here at ten o'clock last night. Mrs. Thompson was charged with causing the death of her infant after leaving the Kingston General Hospital on the first of March last. An autopsy showed that the child died from suffocation, a piece of cloth being tied under its chin. The body was found lying near the C. P. R. tracks near Sharbot Lake.

There was strong evidence against Mrs. Thompson, who is a woman of about 45 years of age, and who had been separated from her husband and living with another man in Kennebec. She did not enter the witness box to give testimony on her own behalf. The jury made a strong recommendation for mercy, and after pronouncing sentence, Justice Lennox stated that he would present Mrs. Thompson's case before the Justice Department. He sentenced her to be hanged on the 17th December next.

Over 20 Families Need Assistance

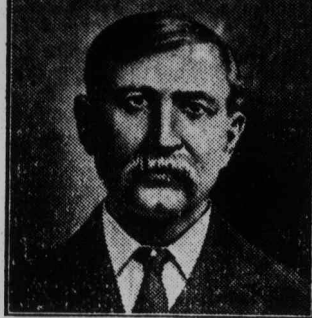
Fredericton, Oct. 2—More than twenty families at Oromocto are in immediate need of assistance as a result of this week's disastrous fire, which wiped out more than half of the village, according to Thomas J. McElroy, one of Oromocto's leading merchants, and the second heaviest loser in the fire. Mr. McElroy is here on business, re his losses, having come here with his daughter this morning. He made a statement to the Gleaner, that while the people were all temporarily housed, there were twenty or more families in need of immediate aid.

Not only do the stricken families need more cooked foods and clothing, but financial assistance is going to be necessary. Several families, as well as some old people, have been rendered not only homeless, but absolutely penniless, declared Mr. Rutledge. "We have a relief committee formed, and I am one of its members. We are ascertaining exactly what is required, but I know that we will want at least \$1,000 in cash and more, too, to meet the requirements of those in need of money. We feel the Provincial Government should step in and help us with a grant."

This morning, Premier Foster was in touch with R. B. Smith, M. L. A., to learn from him the requirements of the fire-stricken people. The Government has been considering giving assistance, but up to the time of writing no announcement has been made as to what action is being taken.

A Clear Explanation of the Income Tax

A very useful digest of the Income War Tax Act of Canada for the year 1917 has been prepared and is being distributed by the Royal Bank of Canada. This document contains the provisions of the Act, and cites all to whom it may apply, and contains the amending Acts of 1918 and 1919. This brings the information up to date, and on the whole the publication constitutes a very clear rendering of the law in the various cases. It shows who may be exempt from the operations of the Income Tax Act and gives figures and instances of the operation of the Act in particular cases. Details are given showing the amount the individual may pay in normal tax, super-tax, etc. Armed with this booklet, there is scarcely a question that might arise which might not be met by the information contained therein.

Hon. W. J. Bowser To Lead Conservatives

Vancouver, B. C., Sept. 30—Hon. W. J. Bowser, former premier of British Columbia, was unanimously chosen as leader of the Conservative party of this province at the conclusion last night of the first provincial party convention held since 1914. Five hundred delegates were present. A feature of the convention was the number of women delegates who attended. The platform adopted by the party, so far as it affected national aims, included tackling the problem of the high cost of living. To this objection of government pre-cooling plants and refrigerators at various points and their control by the government would effectually deal with this question. An aggressive policy of immigration from the British Isles with the encouragement of British farmers in settling upon the lands of this province, was advocated, as well as the promotion of better understanding between capital and labor and the securing of better financial terms between the provinces and the Dominion.

In a rural court the old squire had made a ruling so unfair that three young lawyers at once protested against such a miscarriage of justice. The squire immediately fined each of the lawyers five dollars for contempt of court.

Oct. 9th Fire Prevention Day

By Royal Proclamation, His Excellency, the Governor General of Canada has designated October 9th as Fire Prevention Day. On that day lessons on fire prevention subjects will be given in every public school, public meetings will be held in many of the larger cities, towns and villages, and the owners and occupants of property everywhere throughout Canada will be counselled to give special attention to the removal of fire hazards from their premises.

Fire waste is one of the most serious economic problems confronting Canada at the present time. The public in general is vitally affected by the tremendous losses annually incurred by fire and the enormous expenditure rendered necessary to adequately protect life and property from its ravages. Seeing that at least seventy-five per cent of all fires are caused by carelessness and can therefore be prevented, it is the obvious duty of municipal authorities, fire department officials, boards of trade and other representative citizen bodies to bring the matter to the attention of the people.
