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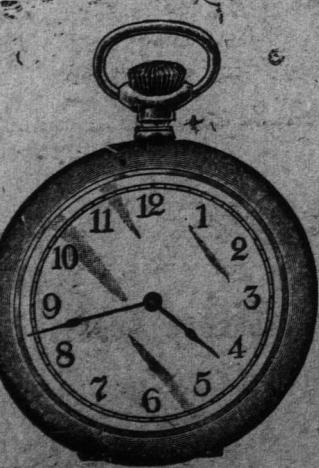

John Peddle, a Newfoundlander

KILLED AT BRITISH COLUMBIA.

Mr. J. Peddle, carpenter, of 16 Queen Street, received a message last evening which conveyed the sad intelligence of his eldest son's death which occurred at Britannia Cove, B. C., on Tuesday last.

The message read as follows:—
"With extreme regret we advise of accident resulting in death of J. P. Peddle at mine, Tuesday evening, remains sent to centre, and Hannas, undertakers, Vancouver. Our deepest sympathy is extended to yourself and family."

On receipt of the news Mr. Peddle wired the undertakers at Vancouver to forward the body for interment here.

The deceased who was better known as Jack Peddle, was an ex-pupil of St. Patrick's Hall Schools and had been for many years a prominent member of the C. C. C.

He had worked as machinist with the Reid Co. for some years, and left here about six years ago for the west where he had been constantly employed.

To the sorrowing family, as well as to the many friends of the deceased, the Telegram extends profound sympathy.
