In the Supreme Court of Newfoundland.

Between The Conception Bay Mutual Marine Insurance Company, Limited, Plaintiff, and C. R. Kennedy, Defendant.

GEORGE THE FIFTH, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas, King, Defender of the Faith, &c.

TO THE DEFENDANT: WE COMMAND YOU, that within fourteen days after the service of this writ on you, with statement of claim, you cause an appearance and defence to be entered for you in this Court in this action, AND TAKE NOTICE that in default of your so doing the plaintiff may proceed therein and judgment may be given in your absence.
