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PUNCTURE-PROOF SERVICE.
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CANADA ISSUES 3,000 LICENSES TO RADIO FANS
Interest in Invention Delays Proposed Union of Government Branches.
TWO DEPUTIES RETAINED
Merging of Militia and Naval Defence Ministries Postponed.

HOUSE OF COMMONS, Ottawa.
April 21.—Canada has been bitten hard by the radiophone bug, according to C. J. Desbarats, deputy minister of naval service for Canada. In addition to more than 3,000 licenses for wireless stations, hundreds of applications for radio apparatus have been granted since April 1.
"It is one of the coming things of the times," said Mr. Desbarats, speaking of the radiophone, "and while as yet the poorer apparatus purchased by amateurs is more or less imperfect, it will not be long before a greater degree of perfection will be reached."
The deputy minister remarked that so numerous had the sales of radio apparatus become that it was really worth while for manufacturing concerns to install broadcast stations and give first-class concerts, if only to advertise themselves.
Exhibitions and tests, he said, had been conducted by the government. Chief of the difficulties encountered was interference. If two broadcast stations were within a short distance of each other, even 150 miles apart, broadcasting at the same time invariably resulted in confusion, experts found.

Reaching Agreement.
Mr. Desbarats declared that should two broadcasting stations fail to reach an agreement regarding the time each should be allowed to operate—such stations being within a short distance of each other—then the department will intercede, allotting a certain time to each station.
To date department officials have found no friction-existent. Newspaper offices with broadcasters, when in close proximity to each other, had settled the matter themselves, not finding it necessary to have the department take a hand in the matter.
In the United States, he believed, licenses were restricted to a great extent, in order to prevent interference.
In London there are over eleven amateur wireless operators, and a considerable number in Brantford, Kitchener, Windsor, Sarnia, Woodstock and other Western Ontario cities.
Toronto has a greater number of operators than any other municipality in Canada, nearly every second operator on the government list having a Toronto address.

Radio Upsets Plan.
When the bill of Hon. George Graham, providing for the union of the department of militia and the department of naval defence was introduced, considerable criticism was levelled at the minister for retaining the two deputy ministers. Mr. Graham replied that the deputy minister of naval affairs would only be kept in office for a few years at the most.
Radio has upset this, for if the increase in the use of wireless and radiophone continues at anything like

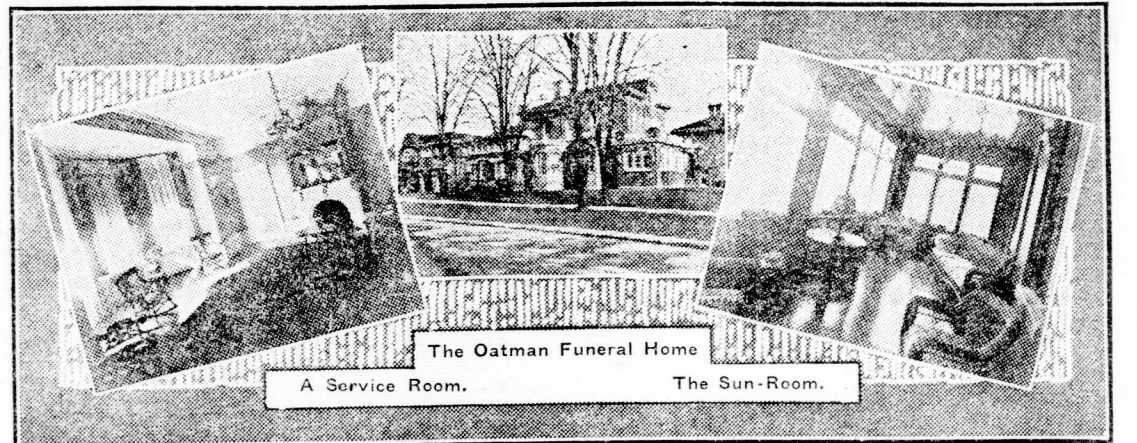
