In the first column to the left are marked the fluctuations of the month. Opposite articles which have advanced in price, is placed the letter A; and opposite articles which have declined, the letter D.

In the column headed "Current Rates" will be found the prices at which Country traders can purchase from most of the respectable houses. The range between the inside and outside figures is caused, chiefly, by the difference in the quality of goods.

The last column, headed "Jobbers' Rates," shows the prices at which round lots can be purchased for cash, or on short terms. The quotations in this column are based on actual sales when there are no sales, they are called.
