College of Physicians and Surgeons, to which, on the doath of Dr. Torrey, was added Medical Jurisprudence.

After his marriago, in 1831, his practice became very extensive, but he did not neglect his literary labors. He published various essays, among which that on "Infantile Therapeutics," stands very high. About three years ago, his health failing, he made a voyage to the West Indies, with however but little benefit; and since the beginning of the year he has been confined

to his chamber, where he found consolation in that religion, which, in health, he had not been aslamed to profess. He died, surrounded by his sorrowing relatives, repeating, by his request, those hymns which had been taught him in his childhood by his widowed mother, who still survives in a green old age.

His remains were attended to the grave, on the 11th April, by one of the largest and most respectable processions ever seen in New York. S.
