Money and Finance

In the year 1967-68, the Council
received from the Government of
the United States of America
approximately \$198,000 for
the purpose of carrying out
its activities. This amount
was used for the purchase of
equipment, salaries, and
other expenses. The Council
also received from the
Government of the United
States of America a grant
of approximately \$100,000
for the purpose of carrying
out its activities.
