8. The Contracting Parties permit the designated airlines of Jamaica, when operating in the territory of Canada:

- (a) to employ without restriction in connection with the agreed services any surface transportation for cargo to or from any points in the territories of the Contracting Parties or in third countries, including transport to and from all airports with customs facilities, and including, where applicable, the right to transport cargo in bond under applicable laws and regulations.
- (b) to have access to airport customs processing and facilities for cargo moving by surface or by air; and
- (c) to elect to perform their own surface transportation or to provide it through arrangements with surface providers, subject to regulatory requirements, including surface transportation operated by other airlines.

Such intermodal cargo services may be offered at a single, through price for the air and surface transportation combined, provided that shippers are fully informed of the identity of the operator and the mode of transportation for each segment of the transportation.
