

His Excellency the Administrator recommends to the House of Commons a measure to provide in the manner prescribed during the period July 1, 1974 to June 30, 1980, in relation to wheat produced outside the designated area as defined in the Canadian Wheat Board Act and, during the period August 1, 1974 to July 31, 1980 in relation to wheat produced in the said designated area, payments in the amounts calculated thereunder in respect of each bushel of durum wheat and in respect of each bushel of wheat other than durum produced and sold for human consumption in Canada; and to provide for interest, in the manner prescribed, in relation to payments between the periods commencing July 1, 1974 and August 1, 1974 respectively and, the time when the measure is enacted.

The House resumed debate on the motion of Mr. Duclos, seconded by Mr. Lee,—That the following Address be presented to His Excellency the Administrator of the Government of Canada:

To His Excellency the Right Honourable Bora Laskin, Chief Justice of Canada and Administrator of the Government of Canada.

#### MAY IT PLEASE YOUR EXCELLENCY:

We, Her Majesty's most loyal and dutiful subjects, the House of Commons of Canada, in Parliament assembled, beg leave to offer our humble thanks to Your Excellency for the gracious Speech which Your Excellency has addressed to both Houses of Parliament.

And on the motion of Mr. Stanfield, seconded by Mr. Wagner, in amendment thereto,—That the following words be added to the Address:

"We respectfully suggest to your Excellency that the failure of your Ministers to act resolutely after the election of July 8th, last, has contributed to the increasing disparity and the social and economic disarray in the country, which require prompt, decisive leadership which is lacking in the Speech from the Throne."

And debate continuing, at 5.30 o'clock p.m., Mr. Speaker interrupted the proceedings pursuant to Standing Order 38(4);
