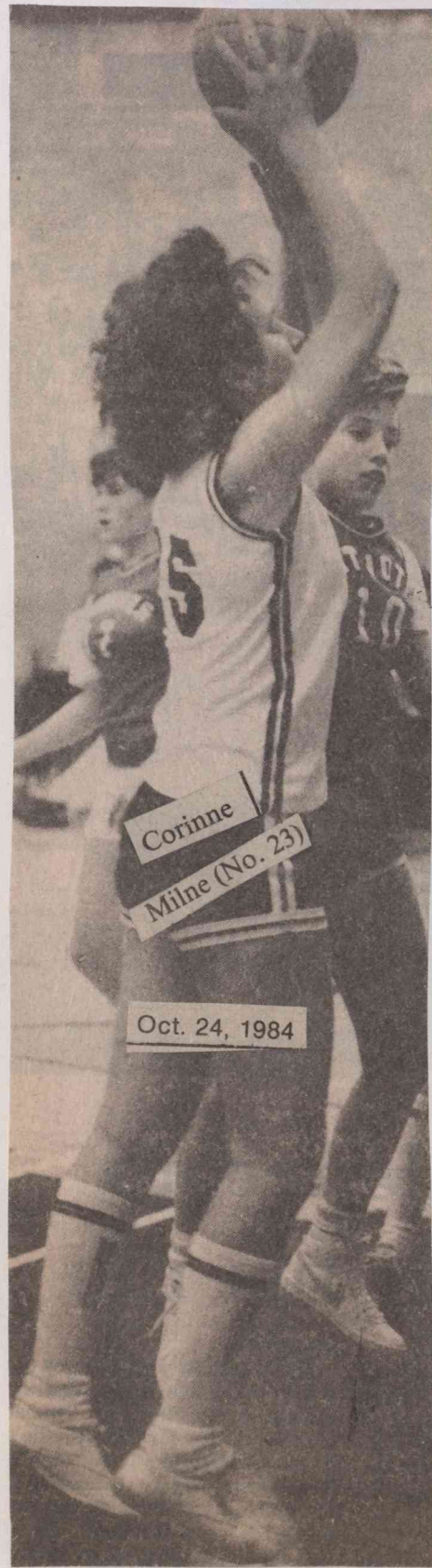
Milne won all of her qualifying heats and then ran the finals in the 100m, 200m and hurdles within an hour. Extremely happy with the sprint victories

Milne, a Mountain Township resident and senior at NDDHS, was the lone athlete from her school to win an EOSSA event and did so in impressive fashion capturing the senior girls 100m in a personal best time of 12.9 seconds. She will also compete in the senior girls open 400m hurdles after qualifying second here at General Vanier in a time of 70 seconds. She won both events the week before in the SD&G championships. Milne just failed to grab one of the four qualifying spots in the 200m sprint, an event she says she prefers and won at SD&G two weeks ago at St. Lawrence High.
