October 10, 1933. My dear President, With further reference to the project of a History of Parliament, in which Professor H.A.L. Fisher proposes that Canadian Universities should have a part, I am enclosing copy of my reply, in which I have said that because of the loss of the late Professor W.T. Waugh and our being left with a depleted Department of History, and because we cannot afford the expense involved, we are unable to do as he suggests. Have you heard any more about it?
