In 1918 the grant from the Department of Public Instruction was increased to \$10,000. per annum and this amount was received during the years 1918-1924 inclusive, after which date it was discontinued. The net cost of operating the School for the year ending 30th, June 1924 amounted to \$34,704. distributed as follows:-Salaries School for Teachers 24,550.
