Coffee, green, not imported from United States.	Oils, cocoa-nut and palm.
Coin and bullion, except United States silver coins.	Pitch, tar and pine.
Duck for belting and hose.	Rags, resin.

Fur skins, not dressed.	Silk, raw, or as reeled from the cocoon.
Fibre, Mexican.	Seeds.
