

quired, has been obtained by means of false statements, the consent may be revoked and considered as not given.

75. Previous by-laws are abrogated. However, in what concerns the transactions, matters and things anterior to the putting into force of these regulations and to which one could not apply the dispositions of them without giving them a retractive effect, the dispositions of preceding by-laws which without these would apply to those transactions, matters and things, remain in force and are applicable therein, and the present is applicable only in so far as it coincides with those dispositions.

These regulations adopted at an assembly of the ancient and new churchwardens of the parish of Notre-Dame of Montreal, held the 3rd of May, 1903, shall become of force the day of their approbation by His Grace the Archbishop of Montreal.
