Baillargeon, Bishop of Tloa, representing the then bishop of Quebec, whose coadjutor he was. The audience was both numerous and select. The Governor General, Sir Edmund Head, and General Eyre, Commander of the Forces, sent letters regretting their inability to attend. Speeches were delivered by the Superintendent, by his Lordship the Coadjutor Bishop,—who expressed the wish that “ the Normal School might be blessed in its founder, “ blessed in its director, blessed in its teachers, blessed “ in its pupils, ”—by the Mayor of Quebec, by the Principal of the School, Reverend Edward J. Horan, by Messrs Toussaint. (1) de Fenouillet, and Doyle, Professors of the Laval Normal School, and Devisme, Professor of the Jacques-Cartier Normal School.

On the following day, the first meeting of the teachers' association in connection with the Laval Normal School was held.
