

the Treasurer and shall prepare annually, or as often as may be required by the Executive Committee or the Association, a financial abstract.

The Treasurer shall furnish bonds, from a guarantee company approved by the Executive Committee of this Association, to the amount of five hundred dollars.

The books and accounts of the Treasurer shall be audited each year, as often as may be required by the Executive Committee, by auditors appointed at the first meeting of the Executive after the Annual Convention. The Treasurer's report shall be presented at the first session of each Convention.

2.—Office Expenses, Etc.

The Association shall bear all office expenses and shall pay for all clerical assistance required for the execution of its work under the authority of the Association or its Executive Committee.

3.—Reports of Officers, Etc.

The members of the Administrative Commission under the Pension Act, the Representative to the Protestant Committee of the Council of Public Instruction, the Librarian and all committees appointed or elected by the Association shall report to the Convention following their appointment or election.

4.—Travelling Expenses at Committee Meetings.

(a) Members of the Executive Committee who attend meetings of the Committee held at places distant from their homes shall be entitled to the reimbursement of their necessary travelling expenses. This clause, however, shall not apply to meetings of the Executive held at the time of Convention.

(b) Members of the committees of Convention and members of sub-committees of the Executive, when attending a meeting of their respective committees or sub-committees, shall be entitled to the reimbursement of their necessary
