

The above map shows the location of the line of railway from Mileage Post 225 on the main line of the Timiskaming & Northern Ontario Railway to Porcupine, a distance of twenty-six miles to the foot of Porcupine Lake.

The steel is now laid for eight miles, and will be across Porcupine River, more than ten miles of the journey, before next Saturday night. Frederickhouse River will be clear of ice and navigable in two weeks up to Hill's Camp, which is shown on the map. The present terminal of the road is at South Porcupine, at the foot of the lake, but it is proposed to extend it later on in the direction of the group of mines known as the Domes, and a little later on past the Hollinger to the Mattagami River, which will allow of the navigation of the Mattaga mi to be in touch with the rails. The main station will be at the townsite at the head of the lake.
