The ravages of a worm, which destroyed the turnip crop. The animal was deposited on the under side of the leaf, and was little more than one-third of its length, being black and grey. These worms, in the early stages of their existence, appeared to be gregarious in their habits, herding together, and sometimes running along a gutter as a body in concert, half a mile or more apart. This is the most suitable opportunity to destroy them, while they can be done dry pinching off the leaf, to which they adhere. In this way, the damage done may be destroyed in a few minutes.
