FURTHER WORD OF DEATH OF MRS. A. B. BRODRICK

Former St. John Woman Was Gathering Flowers When Train Struck Her.

The Ottawa Journal's report of the death of Mrs. Arthur B. Brodrick, formerly of St. John, is here quoted. The Journal's despatch from Santa Barbara, Cal., under date of March 17, says: "Mrs. Arthur B. Brodrick of Ottawa, who with her husband has been spending the winter at Montecito, a fashionable suburb, was instantly killed late yesterday afternoon, when struck by a Southern Pacific passenger train in front of her bungalow.

"The body was carried 850 feet and badly mangled. At the time Mrs. Brodrick was picking flowers from a hedge by her bungalow and the whistling of the engine confused her. She stepped directly in front of the engine. Her husband, attracted by persons running to where the body lay, walked to the spot. He commented upon whom the woman might be, and walked on, not recognizing the body.

"It was not until he returned after his daily stroll, five hours later, and failing to find his wife waiting him, that he became alarmed, and, investigating, identified the body from the jewelled rings his wife wore.

"Mrs. Brodrick had invited the Harrisons, the Macdougalls and other Canadians, who are wintering here, to a brilliant party at her home last night, and it was for this party she was gathering flowers when killed. Mrs. Brodrick collapsed following the identification, and is under a physician's care in a precarious condition.

"The body will be taken to Ottawa."

The tragic news was a great shock to the large circle of friends of both Mr. and Mrs. Brodrick in Ottawa. Few women are given to create such warm and deep friendships as have Mrs. Brodrick's friends in this city. The sweetest, dearest woman in the world, was the glowing tribute paid to the deceased by one of her life-long friends. Of splendid appearance, Mrs. Brodrick passed through life making
