WAR SITUATION LAST NIGHT

New York, Aug. 30-The Associated Press tonight issued the following: There has been no abatement in the strength of the offensive the British, French and American troops are throwing against the German armies from Arras to the region of Soissons. 

Southwest of Ypres, in the Lys salient, the Germans have again begun withdrawing and are being closely followed up by the British. The British again are holding the important town of Bailleul in this sector.

The withdrawal of the Germans seemingly indicates that it is their purpose to blot out this salient and straighten their line toward Ypres. It is a move, however, that is greatly lessening the chance of a drive during the present year toward the channel ports from this region. There has been a considerable increase in the enemy's artillery activity against the American troops in the Vosges region. Several patrol attacks by the Germans have been stopped by the Americans




