



And the nearest of them is so far away that if it is accompanied by a retinue of habitable planets, more or less resembling the earth, a telescope not less than twenty-one feet in diameter would be required to enable us to barely see the Jupiter of such a system. It would need a magnifying power of about 30,000,000 to make our earth, seen from such a distance, look sa large as the moon. Our instruments and methods of observation must be increased in power to an extent which we can hardly hope for in many centuries before we can even see most of the distant worlds on which alone it is possible that life like ours can flourish. It is, of course, conceivable that such improvement may be more rapid than there is now any reason to expect; but in any case there remains the extreme difficulty due to the fact that we have to observe from the surface of the earth, looking upward through many miles of air more or less impure, moved by winds and streaked by currents of varying density. The effect of this atmospheric obstacle increased rapidly with the dimensions of the telescope, and unless some means can be found to neutralize it it is likely that even if we could make a theoretically perfect instrument, ten or fifteen feet in diameter, we should not be able to see with it a great deal more than we can with the Lick telescope, of only three feet aperture.
