

(1) Mr. Lloyd George follow-ed by the Locked Box leaving 10 Downing Street for the House. (2) Dublin Horse Show.


General view of the parade of (3) Rideau Hall, Ottawa, Front Entrance.



Oats Grown With Irrigation Near Brooks, Alberta.

The story of the saving of a large cat and hay crop this year by J. E.
