

Resolved, that the chair appoint a committee of three to nominate a Conference Church Building Committee of five. The three Presiding Elders, J. Umbach and Theo. Hauch were elected.

The committee on deed forms reported as follows:

Your committee has examined the form of deed suggested by lawyer Alex. Millar of Berlin, and compared it with the deed form adopted some years ago, and proposes that

1. The old form be rejected.
2. That the "trust clause" as prescribed by discipline be inserted in the new form as it lies before us, leaving blank spaces between the words "place" and "of the Evangelical Association of North America" and between these last words and "with power."
3. That this new form thus amended be adopted.
4. That 100 copies be printed.
5. That the Presiding Elder of the South District, and the preacher in charge of Berlin, constitute a committee to carry out these resolutions.
6. That said Committee also inquire whether this deed form could be used for parsonages, which are controlled by more than one society, and if not, that they have one drawn up by competent counsel and report to the next Annual Conference.

The report was accepted.

J. W. Hammett had credentials voted him, to unite with the Central Pa. Conference.

Credentials were voted to J. W. Richards.

Resolved, that \$100.00 be appropriated to H. G. G. Schmidt for missionary work during the year.

M. L. Wing reported that he as per conference resolution of last year, acted as representative of this body in organizing a general minister's mutual aid society, and that such a society is now organized with full authority to do business.

The report was adopted.

New Hamburg, Ont., was selected as the place for the next session of conference, to begin the third Thursday in April, 1896, at 9. A. M. The examination of junior preachers shall begin Tuesday previous at 9. A. M.

The committee which was appointed to nominate the Board of Examiners reported and the report was adopted by conference. (For report see page 9 of this Journal.)

S. R. Knechtel was newly elected conference treasurer.

J. W. Hammett who severed his connection with the conference to take work in the Central Pa. Conference spoke a few hearty but appropriate parting words. May the Lord go with the dear brother to his new field. He led in the closing prayer.
