PROVINCE OF NEW BRUNSWICK AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT

Report of Provincial Department of Agriculture Plainly Shows that the Farmers Are Being Well Looked After—Successful Results Along all Lines of Department's Endeavor.

Fredericton, Mar. 13.—The agricultural report was laid upon the table of the House by Dr. Landry, Commissioner for Agriculture. During 1911 charters were granted to eleven new agricultural societies and the farmers in various localities are arranging to organize additional societies during the coming year.

The report contains the usual crop statistics which have been collected under the same plan as in former years. Wheat growing in New Brunswick has not increased during the past five years, neither in the acreage planted nor in the yield per acre.
