Another Union.

And now the Hon. Mr. Willis takes the lead in a movement for the continuation of a Maritime Union, by moving for a delegation to be appointed for the purpose of meeting delegations from Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island.

This Union may be desirable, but we believe that Mr. Willis resorts to these pretences and improbable suppositions as arguments in his favor. He says "it seems reasonable to conclude that a Legislative Union of Nova Scotia, New Brunswick and Prince Edward Island would lessen the expense connected with their Governments and Legislatures and have a tendency to diminish local jealousies which to some extent obstruct their industrial progress, and add to the influence of their representatives in the Federal Parliament, and otherwise promote the interest of their people."

Now, judging by experience, it does not seem reasonable to conclude that the expenses of legislation and government would be lessened.

Is not the cost of the Dominion Parliament and Government as great as that of all the Parliaments and Governments that discharged the functions prior to Confederation? And have the Local Legislatures and Governments also to support. The Legislature of the United Maritime Provinces would be larger than that of either of the existing Legislatures, the pay of the members would be fixed at a higher rate, and there would be an increase in the number and an advance in the salaries of Departmental officers.

The salary of the Lt. Governor would be about half that paid the three Lt. Governors now, and this would be about the only item in which a saving would be effected. If Mr. King should become Attorney General of the Maritime Union he could not attend to more public business than he attends to now, and all the rest would have to be placed in the hands of lawyers whose fees would amount to millions, and the amount of the disbursements of the other two Attorney Generals. Take them all together and it will be seen that there is not the ghost of a chance for effecting a reduction in the cost of legislation and administration. And then, with regard to local jealousies, we see very little, in the history of the Dominion, to warrant the assertion of Mr. Willis. Local jealousies appear to be as strong, and local contentions as paramount, as they have been since Confederation. In the Province of Ontario, the local jealousies and jealousies of Canada East and Canada West were even stronger and more detrimental to the public interests than they were before the union.

Our experience, in fact, is utterly opposed to the presumptions on which Mr. Willis's resolution is based. We are not opposing the motion for entering into negotiations for a Maritime Union, but we are opposing it with an impetuous Montreal gentleman who has been given for such a movement. Legislation for John Young.

The John Young subsidy portion of this bill—the Maritime Electric Telegraphs Bill—is section 16, about which there have been many fruitless inquiries, which reads as follows:

In case any Company heretofore incorporated by any special Act of the Parliament of Canada, has acquired any exclusive privileges of landing wire or cable for a marine telegraph upon the coast of other countries, such company shall be entitled to exercise and

enjoy any such existing privileges maintained by this Act.

Senior Brewster is entitled to the credit of having discovered and disclosed the meaning of this curious section in a bill whose declared purpose is to force the Anglo-American Co. to give up its exclusive privilege in Newfoundland of fishing its rights in Canada. John Young's Company has exclusive privileges in Denmark—a monopoly of landing cables in Iceland, and has power to amalgamate with any other Company.

The bill therefore, while depriving the fishermen of ocean telegraphy of the chartered privileges that induced them to risk their money in a frail wire on the bed of the Atlantic ocean, carefully protects privileges that have not cost John Young one cent, and makes his worthless charter a valuable monopoly. As proof positive that this bill was intended to aid John Young it is only necessary to mention the fact that, last year when this bill was before the House, a bill was put through by the Government extending the John Young charter to the year 1900.
