

Canada has chosen as a case study for the project the Saint John River Basin.

The CCMS meets twice yearly to review the progress of on-going projects, to select new undertakings and to discuss at a senior policy level environmental concerns and activities in each member country. The meeting in Ottawa marks the first time that the CCMS will meet away from the headquarters of NATO at Brussels.

At the Ottawa meeting of the CCMS in April, Canadian experts will have an unusual opportunity to become acquainted with counterpart experts from Europe and the U.S.A. At the same time the visitors will be introduced, in many cases for the first time, directly to Canadian environmental concerns and accomplishments.
