An Act to remove certain doubts as to the mode of making Searches in the Registry Offices in Lower Canada.

WHEREAS it is necessary to remove doubts as to the mode of making searches in the Registry Offices established in Lower Canada, and as to the fees which the Registrars are entitled to receive for such searches; Be it therefore enacted, &c. Preamble.

5 That it shall be lawful for any person wishing to make any search in any Registry Office, to make the same in the presence of the Registrar or of his Deputy; and that in case of such search, if the Registrar is not required to grant a certificate in writing, he shall be entitled to receive *one shilling* for each such search which shall not last more than half an hour, and one shilling more for each additional half hour. How searches may be made.
