NOTE.—A statement of population establishes the Population of Nova Scotia for 1766 at 9,789 souls, divided into 2,575 families.

There appear to have been in 1766, in Nova Scotia :—4,911 acres of land under plough ; 9,870 acres in hay, and 13,646 in pasture :—6,760 bushels of grain and 45,363 bushels of roots raised :—1,131 horses, 10,638 horned cattle, and 6,872 sheep :—21,929 quintals of Cod and 10,013 barrels of other fish caught :—1,132,184 feet of boards manufactured :—24 grist mills and 20 saw mills.
