

apart for such road allowance, in lieu of the road set apart from the land of which he is owner at the time of the passing of this Act, and the County Council may convey such land so retained, in fee to the person or persons so entitled to retain possession, or to his, her or their heirs and assigns for ever.

No road to be stopped up so as to shut off the ingress of any person to his land. V. It shall not be lawful for any Municipality, whether County or Township, after the passing of this Act, to close up any public road or highway, whether such road or highway be an original road allowance, or whether such road has been opened by the Quarter Sessions, County or Township Councils through any land, by which any person may be excluded from ingress or egress to and from his farm or place of residence, but all such roads shall remain open for the use of the said person who shall require the same : Provided always, that when the County Council, for all roads under its supervision, and any Township Council, for all roads under its supervision, shall declare such road no longer to be needed for a public road or highway, then such road and the repairs thereof shall no longer be at the charge of the public, but shall be kept in repair by the party requiring the same.
