

nothing inconsistent with this Act, remain in force until repealed or amended, (as they may be) by the said Corporation, but so much thereof as may be inconsistent with this Act is hereby repealed. Exception.

24thly. The Master, Deputy Master, and wardens of the Trinity House of Quebec, or any three of them, may meet on such days and at such place as they may think proper, and may adjourn indefinitely or to a fixed day, at pleasure; but they shall meet at least twice a week during the season of navigation: their acts shall be valid provided three of them meet at their then usual place of sitting; at their meetings the Master or in his absence the Deputy Master, or if neither be present the senior Warden shall, preside. Meetings of the Corporation. Proviso. Quorum. President.

25thly. At any such meeting the Master, Deputy Master and Wardens of the Trinity House of Quebec, or any three of them, may in the manner provided in the section of this Act, make such By-laws and orders as they may deem fitting and useful, provided the same be not contrary to the Maritime Laws of Great Britain, to the Laws of this Province or to this Act; the objects for which such By-laws and orders shall be made, being the following: T. H. Q. may make By-laws, for certain purposes. Proviso.

1°. The internal management and government of the Corporation of the Trinity House of Quebec and of its property movable and immovable. Purposes for which By-laws may be made.

2°. The security and the facility of the Navigation of the River St. Lawrence, from the Basin of Portneuf, in the County of Portneuf, to the Eastern limit of this Province, and of navigable portions of the several rivers which flow into this river, or into the Gulf of St. Lawrence, within the limits prescribed by this Act.

3°. The placing and removal of buoys and beacons.
