

An Act for the protection of Insectivorous and other Birds,
beneficial to Agriculture.

WHEREAS, the destruction of insectivorous birds is prejudicial to Preamble.
agriculture, and the killing and capture of singing and other small
birds is a useless and cruel practice; Therefore, Her Majesty, &c.,
enacts as follows:

5 **1.** It shall not be lawful to shoot, destroy, kill, wound or injure, or Certain birds
to attempt to shoot, destroy, kill, wound or injure, any kind of bird only may be

10 **2.** It shall not be lawful to take, capture, buy, sell, expose for sale, or taken in
