An Act for the protection of Insectivorous and other Birds, beneficial to Agriculture.

WHEREAS, the destruction of insectivorous birds is prejudicial to Preamble. agriculture, and the killing and capture of singing and other small birds is a usoless and cruel practice; Therefore, Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:

- 1. It shall not be lawful to shoot, destroy, kill, wound or injure, or Certain birds to attempt to shoot, destroy, kill, wound or injure, any kind of bird only may be killed at cerwhatsoever, save and except eagles, falcons, hawks, wild pigeons, tain seasons. ortelans, snow birds and king-fishers,—between the first day of March and the first day of August in any year.
- 2. It shall not be lawful to take, capture, buy, sell, expose for sale, or taken in or have in possession, any kind of bird whatsoever, save and except the exposed for kinds above excepted; or to set either wholly or in part, any net, trap, sale. spring, snare, cage, or other machine or engine, by which any kind of bird whatsoever, save and except the kinds above excepted, might be 15 killed or captured, between the first day of March and the first day of August in any year.

3. It shall not be lawful to take, injure, destroy, or have in posses- Nest, young sion, any nest, young, or egg of any kind of bird whatsoever, except of to be taken. cagles, hawks, falcons and kingfishers, between the said first day of 20 March and the said first day of August in any year.

The violation of any provision of this Act shall subject the of- Penalty for fender to the payment of a penalty of not less than one dollar and not contravention of this Act. more than tendollars, to be recovered in a summary manner by summons How recoverbefore one Justice of the Peace, who shall award the penalty the of- able, &c. 25 fender may be condemned to pay to the prosecutor, with all fees and costs incurred; and in default of immediate payment thereof, the offender shall be forthwith imprisoned in the nearest common jail for a period not less than two and not more than twenty days at the discretion of such Justice.

Any person may seize on view any bird unlawfully possessed, and Nests, traps, carry the same before any Justice of the Peace to be by him confis- &c., unlawfully set may cated; and every person is authorized to destroy all nets, traps, snares, be destroyed. cages, or other machines or engines, set wholly or in part, whereby any kind of bird whatsoever, save and except the kinds above excepted in 25 the first section of this Act, might be unlawfully killed or captured.

- 6. No conviction shall be annulled or vacated for any defect in the Conviction 6. No conviction shall be annulled or vacated for any defect in the form thereof or for any omission or informality in any summons or not not invalid for want other proceedings under this Act, so long as no substantial injustice of form. results therefrom.
- 7. The present Act and all its provisions shall be so construed as not Act not to annul or vacate any provision of the Game Acts of Canada, or any Game Acts. amendments thereto.
