CHAP. 48.

An Act to amend an Act to provide for the Conditional Liberation of Penitentiary Convicts.

[Assented to 7th May, 1900.]

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

- 1. The provisions of chapter 49 of the statutes of 1899, 1899, c. 49 intituled An Act to provide for the conditional liberation of applied to Penitentiary Convicts, shall apply to all persons convicted of ialis and other any offence and being under sentence of imprisonment in any public or any other public or reformatory prison; and the Governor prisons. General may grant to any person so convicted and being under imprisonment in any jail or other public or reformatory prison a license to be at large in Canada upon the like terms and conditions as are by the said Act prescribed and authorized with respect to penitentiary convicts.
- 2. The said Act and this Act may be cited respectively as Short titles. The Ticket of Leave Act, 1899, and The Ticket of Leave Amendment Act, 1900, and may be cited collectively as The Ticket of Leave Acts.
