## LINCOLN, July 10th, 1912

David Watson secretary of the Association reports as follows;— "E.J.Lovelace before leaving for the East arranged with Harvey Wilcox of Niagara Falls and myself to look after the lists for this year. Wilcox is a new man at the work and I have only a limited time. Will be pleased to have the assistance of organizer W.H. Adams when he comes over. Lovelace left instructions for the Voters lists to be sent to my address and as they arrive I will send the General Office a copy. Merritton list was posted Juhe 15th. Send me 25 V.N.C. forms. JULY 11th

Organizer Adams visited St. Catharines to-day and conferred with Secretary David Watson who introduced Adams to a number of Liberals. Wilcox, the Liberal organizer is to start work in Merritton on the 15th day July. G.B. Burson, the president of the Association is instructing Wilcox and will assist him in the revision. G.P. Burson will also oversee the appeals at the Courts of revision. MULY 12th

Organizer Adams conferred with President Burson and Assistant Secretary Brown. The Executive undertakes to see that the lists in Lincoln are thoroughly revised E.J.Lovelace, last Dominion Candidate, is also taking an active interest and expects to return here in the Fall from Saskatoon. Lovelace is regarded as the probable candidate again. Port Dalhousie list posted July 15th.
