Re: Grown Assets Allocation Committee Precedure for Disposal of United States America Nor Assets in Careda

Under the terms of an agreement being negotiated between Canada and the United States, governing the disposal of defence facilities surplus to United States requirements in Canada, it is contemplated that the price paid by Canada for isomethics acquired shall be determined by joint apprelial; and that negotiate which the United States desire to leave in Canada, shall be disposed of through an agency of the Canadian Government designated for the purpose.

The Minister of Manitions and Supply reports that on the recommendation of Grown Assets Allesation Committee be has designated the Grown Assets Allesation Committee and the War Assets Corporation as the agencies of the Canadian Government for the purpose of carrying out this agreement.

It will be the responsibility of the Mar Assets Corporation, acting on references by the Grown Assets Allocation Committee:

- (1) to act as appraisers, in respect of immovables on behalf of the government; and, in respect of movables, to set prices under the working agreement with the United States authorities as provided; and to arrange payment to the United States authorities;
- (11) to dispose of the items concerned.
