



Ottawa 21st May, 1909.

Sir,

With reference to your report of the 2nd instant, regarding certain persons belonging to Mr Daniel Chisholm's Agency, and your recommendation that Mrs Peter Joe Cope be placed either in some "humane institution", or in the keeping of some responsible person, I beg to say that under the circumstances a more definite recommendation should have been made, and while on the ground you should have made enquiries as to the accommodation which could be had. The Department at this distance can not well arrange to have the woman placed in an institution or with a private family. Moreover it looks to you to make such arrangements, subject to approval. Be good enough therefore, without loss of time, to ascertain what accommodation can be had, and report the matter, together with your recommendation in regard thereto.
