

at Fort à la Corne, I have to inform you that the Indian Commr. for the N. W. T., who has had your letter and the Agents report before him, thinks that such an exchange would be most desirable.

2. With regard to the request of the Indians of John Smith's Reserve to be furnished with a small number of pigs which they say they have been promised for a long time, I have to request that you will report on their application.

3. As respects the Band designated by Mr. Mackenzie as "Peter Chapman's," the Dept. has no knowledge of them under that designation. I assume, however, that he refers to the section of the Cumberland Band where Reserve is situated near
