I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 27th inst., reporting with regard to certain repairs proposed to be made to the King's Indian School; and in reply, I beg to inform you that the children's table and the spring may be repaired and brackets purchased, at a cost not exceeding that mentioned in your letter.

As regards the other work, the Department does not approve of the same being rebuilt, as it appears that when lodged in the cellar, during the spring and fall, which is very injurious.
