1959 Treaty 9 Annuity Paylist

Following a check of your 1959 annuity paylist, we wish to bring the under-noted to your attention.

#197 Fort Hope Band-should show three boys and one girl - amend paylist.

#213 Fort Hope Band-should show three boys and four girls - amend paylist.

#485 Fort Hope Band-should show two boys and one girl - amend paylist.

#547 Fort Hope Band-arrears for 1957 were paid to Thomas Sagutch by voucher No. 880 dated September 9, 1957. This over-payment of \$4.00 is to be refunded to Ottawa by January 15, on a Supplementary Receiver General sheet. If you are unable to collect from Thomas Sagutch, the refund is to be made from personal funds, reimbursing yourself when you are able to collect from Mr. Sagutch.

On the page ending with No. 224 Fort Hope Band, there is an error in the addition of the arrears paid which should total \$52.00. Please amend.

It would appear that the child, John Edward on ticket No. 48, Long Lac 77 Band, was paid on tickets No. 48 and 125 at the 1958 payment, in which case, the over-payment of \$4.00 is to be collected and remitted to Ottawa.
