

10. The financial implications of the proposal to reopen RMC including the All Arms Course and the Militia Staff Course are estimated to be as follows:

Note (a) Since the legality of such an undertaking, especially in the case of a minor, could probably not be established, it is for consideration that this requirement should be worded to read:

"A cadet should be required on admission to RMC to undertake upon graduation to serve either in the Active or Reserve Force, whichever he may elect".

The Military Committee recommends this form of undertaking.
