or Came As a Friend-Four of His sets Took Effect-Procurator Wounded-Arrest of the Slayer -St. "Fetersburg's Idea.

Helsingtors, Feb. 7.—Soisalon Soin-claten, Procurator-General of Fin-land, who before he was embolled was known by the name of Johnsson, was assassinated vesterday by a young man, whose identity up to the present time has not been deter-mined. The assassin and Soinington's

The present time has not been determined. The assassin and Soininten's son were both wounded in a revolewer duel following the killing. The motive of the crime apparently was purely political, the slain official being a prominent member of the Government party.

The murderer appeared at the procurator's residence at 11 o'clock yesuterday and sent in a card bearing in information the name of Alexander Gadd, who is in the Russian service. The young man, who was smartly dressed in an officer's uniform, was promptly admitted to the officials private study, and on his entrance affired feur shots from a revolver, one set the hullets piercing the breast of the procurator, who expired almost familiately.

Son Fights Assassiu.

His 17-year old son, hearing the shots, rushed in from an adjoining who is, rushed in from an adjoining woom and fired three or four shots at his father's assailant, whose right deg was broken below the knee by a bullet. He was also slightly wounded in the shoulder, and a finger of his hand was struck. The assassin fired the one bullet remaining in his sewolver at Sominten's son, wounding from slightly in the calf of his stricks her. He then enterwived to severe the service of the service right leg. He then endeavored to escape, but fell unconscious to the u The assassin was removed to the surgical hospital, where he lies guarded by police, answering no questions and evidently unconscious. His recovery, however is thought to be certain. Up to the present the authorities have been unable to identify him. He is of dark complexion and apparently between 25 and 30

The Senator's Career.

Johnson was born in 1856, and practiced at the Finnish bar. He was highly esteemed, and had held various Government appointments, including that of provincial judge. He was appointed Procurator of the Senate in 1901, and in the same year was made Procurator-General of the Duchy of Finland. Johnson was re-resided as a wise and patriotic offi-tial. It is understood that it was at this initiative that the Finns exiled by Governor-General Bobrikoff were allowed to return to Finland.
