All goods not enumerated in this Act, or any other Act, as charged with any duty of Customs, and not declared free of duty by this Act or some un-repealed Act or provision, shall be charged with a duty of twenty per cent. *ad valorem*, when imported into Canada, or taken out of warehouse for consumption therein.

*The following articles shall be prohibited to be imported, under a penalty of two hundred dollars, together with the forfeiture of the parcel or package of goods in which the same may be found, viz:*

Books, printed papers, drawings, paintings, prints, photographs, or representations of any kind of a treasonable or seditious, or of an immoral or indecent character.

Coin, base or counterfeit,

The following articles being the natural products, or the manufactures of the colony of Newfoundland, are exempted from Customs duty when imported into Canada, viz:

Fish—Fresh, dried, salted or smoked.

Fish-oil and all products of fish. Seal-oil. Animals of all kinds.

Inspection fee on Petroleum, 5c per barrel if not more than 50 galls; over 50 galls, 5c extra for every 50 galls; not more than 10 galls, 3 cts. \*

\* It is expected that these inspection fees will be increased.
