VI. And be it Enasted, That the Duties of Excife on all Wines, Molaffes, Sugar, Rum and other diffilled Spirituous Liquors, which shall be in the Hands of any Person as Stock, at the Time of the Sale or Contract for the said Duties, to the Farmer thereof, within the District which shall be fo farm'd by him, shall be paid to such Farmer by the Person who shall be liable by said Stock Account to pay the same by Law, at the Time he ought to pay faid Duties to the Collector or Receiver thereof, and if any Collector shall have received any Duties for such Stock which shall be delivered over to the Farmer, he shall pay such Sums for received to the Farmer as aforesaid.

VII. And to prevent the Farmers of the faid Duties from laying a Quantity of Rum and other Spirits, and Wines, Sugar and Molaffes at any Time during their Contracts, and thereby injuring the Province Revenue after the Expiration thereof;

Be it Enacted, That all Beer, Rum and other diffilled Spirituous Liquors, and Wines, Sugar and Molaffes, which at the Expiration of the faid Thirty First Day of December, One Thoufand Seven Hundred and Seventy Six, shall remain on Hand within any District, farmed out as aforefaid, shall be liable to pay the Duties which shall be imposed on the like Articles by any Law of this Province, and the faid Farmers shall account to the Treasurer for all Monies which they shall have received for such Stock which shall be then found on Hand.

The Duties on all Wines &c. as Stock at the Time of the Sale or Contract by the Farmer, to be paid to fuch Farmer.

All Beer, Rum, &c. remaining at the Expiration of the 31ft Dec. 1776, liable to pay Duties.
