CHICAGO, Aug. 29.—Corn closed today at a fair advance for the deferred options, but at a net loss of 1-32 for September. Pessimistic crop talk lifted December and May, but heavy liquidation depressed September. At the finish the range was 1-8 lower to 1-2 higher. Wheat closed a shade to 1-4 net lower, oats 1-4 to 3-8 up and provisions 2-12 to 25c higher.

The Liverpool market closed 1/2 to 3/4 lower on wheat, and unchanged to 1/4 lower on corn. Antwerp wheat closed 1/4 lower, Berlin 1/4 lower, Budapest 3/8 lower, and Paris 3/4 to 1/2 lower.
