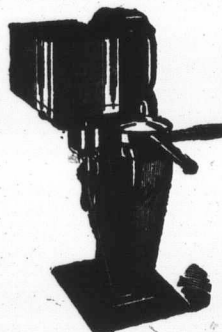

## FROM SUNNY ALBERTA

Edison, Alta., May 18, 1908

Dear Old Reporter,—  
Kindly find the cash enclosed to extend my subscription to your most valuable paper. At the present time I would feel at a great loss without it. Seeding is progressing very favorably, the soil being in fine condition.

Mr. John Baldwin informs us that a town site will be located here. This town will be on the Main line of the C. N. R. to Athabasca Landing. Mr. John Baldwin and Eli are old Prescott Ont. boys. A big plant, a short distance north of here, is boring for oil.

Mr. Tom Nunn, formerly of Caintown, had his house with contents burned one week ago, caused by a rush fire. His loss will be quite heavy—a very hard blow to a homesteader, just getting started.

No doubt many of your readers got very bad reports about this terrible muddy country around Edmonton last fall by a couple of very tender feet, so I will give you a few facts about it so you can judge for yourselves. Since the 15th of Sept. last till the 15th of this May, 8 months, we have not had a rain to speak of, during the winter, a bad snow-storm or a blustering day that you Eastern people would call bad.

What snow we had came in little flurries, never had more than six inches any one time. We had a few windy days, but the mercury was always above freezing and it was not disagreeable. There were very few cold days all winter, never more than 25 deg. below zero. Cloudy weather here in the winter is an exception—the rule is bright, clear and sunny days. On Saturday night and Sunday we got a good rain (16 and 17 of May), but nothing seemed to be suffering for moisture, notwithstanding the small amount of rain and light snow fall in 8 months. Stevens and Halladay have their cheese factory nearly finished. On Tuesday morning, May 20th they took in their first milk. The building is one of the best in Ontario, built of brick 30x82½ feet, comprising boiler room, manufacturing room, cold storage and ice house, all under one roof. The building stands in a beautiful maple grove. The floors are of cement, and painted. They put in two new steel vats and have two of the common woodens vats as well. They can manufacture 35000 lbs of milk a day. W. B. Phelps is the agent here for the above steel vats.

The farm work has been very slow this spring owing to the wet.

Many of the cows are not milking as well this season, owing to the scarcity and high price of feed, and a number of cows have died from one cause and another.

### Stained Ivory.

Spots or yellow stains on Ivory can be removed by one or more applications of sawdust very slightly dampened with water and made into a paste by adding lemon juice squeezed from a fresh lemon. The paste should be laid over the surface and allowed to dry thoroughly, after which it must be brushed off, or moistened a piece of flannel with water, dip it in finely crushed table salt and rub gently.
